Rate of Play

Chess clocks will be used.

Each player will have 15 mins plus a 2 second increment per move from move 1.

Time Table

Round 1 commences at 10:00.

There will be 7 rounds.

No one is knocked out and all players should come to every round.

We aim to start subsequent rounds about 5 minutes after completion of the previous round. There will be a short break of 15 minutes close to 13:00.

Our aim is to finish by about 15:30 or earlier, dependent on the length of rounds.

Venue

Prospect House, Sandy Lane, Leyland PR25 2EE

The venue is only 5 minutes from the M6, exit 28

There is free car parking.

Exit the motorway at junction 28, turn left (from north or South) towards Leyland. At the roundabout after Tesco Express, turn left into Canberra Road. Take the 3rd right down Broadway. Cross over Balcarras Road onto Sandy Lane. Prospect house halfway down Sandy Lane on the right.

Any player scoring 17 points or more will qualify for the Area Megafinal.
Besides this, the leading scorers at U7, U8, U9, U10 and U11, both boys and girls,
also qualify, as long as they have played at least 5 out of the 7 rounds and
providing that the place in the section has not already been
taken by a player scoring 17 or more points.
If there is a tie for a place, the tied players all qualify.

Secondary School pupils do not need to qualify to enter the Megafinal stage.
All Secondary pupils are welcome to play at the Leyland Last Chance Saloon.

The Megafinal at Poulton is arranged for Saturday 28 April.

Pairings

Five minutes after the start of each round, new pairings may be made for each
