U18 Open

For all players under 18 years of age on 31st August 2017. ECF graded section, no max grade.

Format

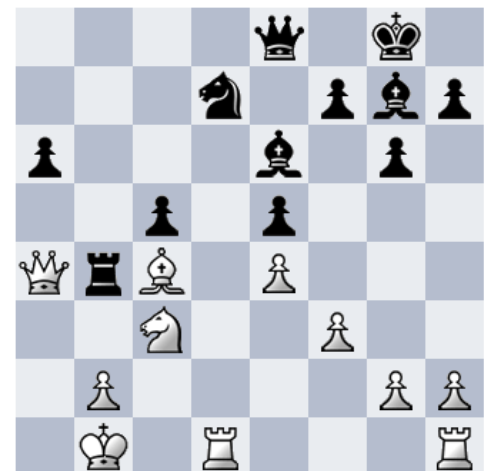
Swiss Tournament. All players play in all rounds. All sections are rapidplay with 20 mins + 3 second increment.
